

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type fork carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type fork carriages have been consistent.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is something like thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks can vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the tine. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
